### Contestant Rules

The St. Tammany Parish Rodeo will be held October 1st and 2nd, 2021. Contestants must be between the ages of 13 and 19 years of age (19 as of January 1 of the competing year). The contestant must be a resident of or attend a school in St. Tammany, Washington or Tangipahoa Parish. Contestants must be single, never married and never had a child. Contestants cannot be living in common law. Interviews and Queens contest will be held on September 26, 2021 at St. Tammany Parish Fair Grounds, 1304 North Columbia St. Covington, La. Rodeo Queen interviews will begin at **11 am**, with horsemanship to follow. The crowning of the Queen will take place during the first performance of the Rodeo on Friday, October 1, 2021.

All contestants must be present for **both** the competition and crowning to be eligible to hold the St. Tammany Parish Rodeo Queen Title. The Queen will ride in the grand entry of the Saturday night rodeo performance. Full western attire is required at all times for any events pertaining to the Rodeo Queen's contest.

The contestants will be judged on appearance, horsemanship and interviewed by judges. All scores will be totaled and averaged for the final result. Each contestant will be asked to sell a minimum 5 adult rodeo tickets. The ticket money must be turned in on the day of competition.

Contestants must provide their own horse for competition, crowning and the duration of her reign. Horse must be **safe, healthy** and in **good condition**.

All contestants are required to have a current negative Coggins Test on any horses brought into the facility.

Alcohol and drug consumption will not be tolerated.
